AN ACT TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE.

Chapter 235, Vol. VIII, page 295.

[Date of Assent: October 14, 1966]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Short title. (Amendment) Act, No. 29 of 1966.
- 2. Schedule A to the Customs Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution, for all the words from "consigned from, the United Kingdom" to "Togoland under British Mandate.", of the following words:
