## Law Commission (Special Provisions) Law, No. 23 of 1977

A Law to provide for the continuance in force of the Law Commission Act. No. 3 of 1969, and for that purpose to releal the Law Commission (Repeal) Act, No. 8 of 1972, which has not been brought into operation.

BE it enacted by the National State Assembly of the Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Law Commission shore title (Special Provisions) Law, No. 23 of 1977.
- 2. The Law Commission (Repeal) Act, No. 8 of Repeal of Act, No. 8 of 1975.
