A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC SERVICE MUTUAL
PROVIDENT ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the National State Assembly of the
Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Service
Mutual Provident Association (Amendment) Law,
No. 2 of 1978.

Short title.

2. Section 6 of the Public Service Mutual
Provident Association Ordinance, hereinafter
referred to as the "principal enactment", as amended
by Act No. 15 of 1966 and Law No. 54 of 1973, is
hereby further amended by the substitution, for the
proviso to subsection (2) of that section, of the
following new proviso:—

" Provided that such remuneration shall not
exceed the sum of three hundred rupees per
month or proportionately for any part of a
month."

3. Section 18 of the principal enactment is hereby
amended by the substitution, for subsection (1) of
that section, of the following new subsection:—

" (1) An annual general meeting of the members
of the corporation shall be held not later than the
thirtieth day of June in each year, when there
shall be submitted a balance sheet, a profit and
loss account, and an account of receipts and dis-
bursements during the twelve months ending on
the thirty-first day of December preceding, all of
which shall be prepared by the joint secretary
and treasurer and duly audited."

4. The amendment made to section 18 of the
principal enactment by section 3 of this Law shall be
deemed to have come into operation on August 1, 1976 ;
and accordingly the annual general meeting of the
members of the corporation held on June 4, 1977, and
the business transacted at such meeting shall be
deemed to have been duly held and transacted under
and in accordance with the provisions of section 18 of
the principal enactment as amended by section 3 of
this Law.
