A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY
REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

BE it enacted by the National State Assembly of the Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Deputy Short title. Registrar-General (Appointment) Law, No. 23 of 1978.
- 2. (1) There may be appointed a fit and proper person to be or to act as a Deputy Registrar-General.

(2) The Deputy Registrar-General may, subject to the authority and control of the Registrar-General for the time being, exercise, perform or discharge any power, duty or function conferred or imposed upon such Registrar-General by or under any written law.

Appointment of Deputy Registrar-General and his duties.

8. In this Law-

Interpretation.

- "Registrar-General" includes—
 - (a) the Registrar-General of Births and Deaths appointed under section 2 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act (Chapter 110);
 - (b) the Registrar-General of Marriages appointed under section 2 of the Marriage Registration Ordinance (Chapter 112); and
 - (c) the Registrar-General of Lands appointed under section 2 of the Registration of Documents Ordinance (Chapter 117).
