National Science Council of Sri Lanka (Amendment)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE NATIONAL SCIENCE COUNCIL OF
SRI LANKA LAW, NO. 36 OF 1975.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist
Republic of Sri Lanka as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Science Council
of Sri Lanka (Amendment) Act, No. 7 of 1980.

Short
title.

2. Section 6 of the National Science Council of Sri Lanka
Law, No. 36 of 1975, (hereinafter referred to as the “prin-
cipal enactment”) is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-
section (1) of that section and the substitution therefore of
the following new subsection :—

(1) The Council shall consist of the following members:—

(a) eight members (hereinafter referred to as “appointed
members”) appointed by the Minister from among
persons who have distinguished themselves in
science and technology in any of the following
fields :—

Pure Science, Agriculture, Medicine, Engineering,
Forestry and allied fields, Industry, Education,
Planning, Irrigation and Power, Geology, Social
Science, and any other fields that have relevance
to the application of science and technology to
national development; and

(b) three *ex officio* members, namely—

- (i) the Secretary-General of the Council;
- (ii) the Secretary to the Ministry in charge of the
Minister to whom the subject of Scientific
Affairs has been assigned or a representative
of the Ministry nominated by the Secretary;
and
- (iii) the Secretary to the Ministry in charge of the
Minister to whom the subject of Finance
has been assigned or a representative of the
Ministry nominated by the Secretary.

3. Section 16 of the principal enactment is hereby repeal-
ed and the following new section substituted therefor :—

“Remunera-
tion of
members of
the Board.” 16. All or any of the members may be
paid such remuneration out of the fund of
the Council, as may be determined by the
Minister with the concurrence of the Minister
to whom the subject of Finance has been
assigned.”
