## An Ordinance to amend the Ordinance No. 6 of 1885.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinance No. 6 of 1885, intituled "An Ordinance to enable the Bishop, Clergy, and Laity of the Church of England in Ceylon to provide for the regulation of the affairs of the said Church:" Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Section 9 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1885 amended. 1 In section 9 of the Ordinance No. 6 of 1885, the words "not less than five" shall be inserted after the words "any number of persons," and the following words shall be inserted immediately before the proviso to the said section:

Incorporated trustees.

Provided that the seal of the said corporation shall not be affixed to any instrument except in the presence of three at least of the members of such corporation, who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence, and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person who may sign the instrument as a witness.

To be read with Ordinance No. 6 of 1885. 2 This Ordinance shall be read as one with the Ordinance No. 6 of 1885.
