An Ordinance to amend "The Colombo Waterworks Ordinance, 1886."

(See No. 7 of 1886.)

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Colombo Waterworks Ordinance, 1886," hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance:" Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

To be read as one with the Ordinance No. 7 of 1886. Short title. 1 This Ordinance shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance, and may be cited as "The Colombo Waterworks Ordinance, 1891," and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited collectively as "The Colombo Waterworks Ordinances, 1886 and 1891."

Amendment of section 16 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1886. Water may be supplied for other than domestic purposes, subject to conditions made by the 2 For section 16 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted, namely:

Independently of the water or consolidated rate leviable under section 12, and the expenses payable under section 5, the Waterworks Engineer, on behalf of the Ceylon Government, may agree with any person to supply water for other than domestic purposes, in such manner, on such terms, and subject to such conditions and regulations as may from time to time be determined and made by the Governor in Executive Council.

3 In section 17 of the principal Ordinance the words "by meter" shall be omitted.

Amendment of section 34. 4 For sub-section (f) of section 34 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:

(f) For regulating the supply of water under section 16, and the materials and fittings to be used therefor, and the use of water meters when required.
