*An Ordinance to authorize the establishment of a
Special Cemetery for the burial of the dead of the
Mohammedan community.*

WHEREAS certain members of the Mohammedan community Preamble.
have obtained a grant of a parcel of land at Dematagoda for
the purposes of a special Cemetery, and it is expedient that the same
should be established for that purpose: **IT IS HEREBY
ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR OF CEYLON,** with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

THE Governor with the advice of the Executive Council may by Power to establish
special cemetery at
Dematagoda for
Mohammedan
community.
**Proclamation establish the said parcel of land as a Cemetery for the
special use of the Mohammedan community, and thereupon the provi-
sions of "The Cemeteries Ordinance, 1862," shall apply in all
respects to the said special Cemetery as if the same were a General
Cemetery established under the said Ordinance.**

hundred and eighty.
