An Ordinance to authorize the establishment of a Special Cemetery for the burial of the dead of the Mohammedan community

WEREAS certain members of the Mohammedan community Preamble. have obtained a grant of a parcel of land at Dematagoda for the purposes of a special Cemetery, and it is expedient that the same should be established for that purpose: It IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR OF CEYLON, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :-

THE Governor with the advice of the Executive Council may by Proclamation establish the said parcel of land as a Cemetery for the special use of the Mohan medan community, and thereupon the provisions of "The Cemeteries Ordinance, 1862," shall apply in all respects to the said special Cemetery as if the same were a General Cemetery established under the said Ordinance.

Power to establish special cometery at Dematagoda for Mohammedan community.
