7 HEREAS by the 3rd section of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1876. intituled "An Ordinance to repeal the Wharf and Warehouse Ordinance, 1565, and to make further provision for the establishment in Colombo and regulation of a Company to perform the duties of Wharfingers and Warehousemen," it is enucred that the said Ordinance should continue in force until the 30th day of June, 1880 : And whereas by the Ordinance No. 15 of 1879, intiruled " An Ordinance for continuing the Ordinance No. 10 of 1876, intituled 'An Ordinance to repeal the Wharf and Warehouse Ordinance, 1.65, and to make further provision for the establishment in Colombo and regulation of a Company to perform the duties of Wharfingers and Warehousemen," the said Ordinance No. 10 of 1876 was continued in force until the end of the Sessions of the Legislative Council of the year 1880: And whereas it is necessary to amend and continue the said Ordinance No. 10 of 1876 in the manner hereinafter appearing, BE IT KNOWN THAT IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR OF CLYLON, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-
