An Ordinance to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861."

(See No. 10 of 1861.)

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861," in the particular hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Provise to be read as added to, and contained in, section 23 of "The Road Ordinance, 1861," empowering the Governor, with the nivice of the Executive Council, to appoint an additional member to a district committee.

1 From and after the passing of this Ordinance, section 23 of "The Road Ordinance, 1861," shall be taken and read as though the following proviso were added thereto and contained therein:

Provided also that it shall be lawful for the Governor, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, to appoint any fit and proper person as an additional member of the district committee of any district in which such appointment is applied for by the provincial road committee, or is otherwise made to appear to him to be expedient.

This Ordinance to be read as one with "The Road Ordinance, 1861," 2 This Ordinance and "The Road Ordinance, 1861," shall be construed and read as one Ordinance.
