An Ordinance amending "The Toll Ordinance, 1867."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Toll Ordinance, 1867," in the particulars hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Preamble.

1 This Ordinance shall come into operation from and after first January, 1888, and shall be read and construed as one with Ordinance No. 14 of 1867, herein referred to as "the principal Ordinance," and Ordinance No. 2 of 1882.

Commencement.
Ordinance to be read as one with Ordinances No. 14 of 1867 and No. 2 of 1882.

2 Section 4 of the principal Ordinance shall be taken and read as though the words "whether drawn or propelled by man or beast" were inserted after the words "every vehicle not enumerated above."

Section 4 of Ordinance No. 14 of 1867 amended.

Provided, however, that the maximum rate leviable on bicycles, tricycles, and jinrickshas shall be twelve and a half cents.
