An Ordinance to exempt Materials used in making Tea Boxes from Duty of Customs.

WHEREAS it is expedient to exempt materials imported into this colony for making tea boxes from the duty of customs leviable under the authority of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, intituled "An Ordinance for the General Regulation of Customs in the Island of Ceylon:" Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Preamble.

From and after the passing of this Ordinance, all materials which are used in making tea boxes, and which shall from time to time be specified in any Proclamation issued by the Governor in Executive Council, and published in the Government Gazette, may be imported into this colony free of duty of customs, anything in the Ordinance No. 17 of 1869, or the Ordinance No. 14 of 1871, or the Ordinance No. 39 of 1884, to the contrary notwithstanding; and it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council, by further Proclamation published in the Government Gazette, to revoke, alter, or amend any such Proclamation as aforesaid.

Governor in Executive Conneil by Proclamation to specify what materials imported into this colony, and used to making tea boxes, shall pass free of duty of customs.
