*An Ordinance to prolong the duration of the Ordinance No. 12  
of 1869.*

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the Ordinance No. 12 of 1869, entitled "*An Ordinance to regulate the use of Traction Engines,*" will cease to have effect on the 31st December next, and it is expedient to continue the same in force for another year: **IT IS THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE GOVERNOR OF CEYLON,** with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Ordinance No. 12 of 1869 to continue in force till 31st December, 1871.

This Ordinance and Ordinance No. 12 of 1869 to be deemed one.

1. **THE** said Ordinance, No. 12 of 1869, shall continue in force after the 31st day of December next, and until the 31st day of December, 1871.

2. **THIS** Ordinance and the said Ordinance No. 12 of 1869 shall be read and construed as if they formed one Ordinance.
