An Ordinance to further amend "The Toll Ordinance, 1867."

(See No. 14 of 1867.)

Preamble.

WHEREAS the fourth section of "The Toll Ordinance, 1867," provides for exemptions from toll in manner therein appearing, and it is deemed expedient to create further exemptions in favour of substances used for checking leaf-disease in the island: It is therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Toll Ordinance, 1867, further Amendment Ordinance, 1879."

Governor may exempt certain substances from toll.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor, from time to time, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, to declare an exemption from toll in favour of any substance or substances in use for checking leaf-disease in coffee and other plantations in the island.

3 After the publication in the *Government Gazette* of such Proclamation no toll shall be demanded or taken for or in respect of any horse, ox, vehicle, boat, or canoe, when employed or going to be or returning from being employed in carrying or conveying only the substance or substances specified for exemption from toll in such Proclamation, or only such substance or substances, together with any other substance or substances exempted from toll by the Toll Ordinance aforesaid, or by Proclamation under the Ordinance No. 7 of 1875, or by any Proclamation in force under this Ordinance, and the necessary implements used for loading the substances exempted, and in the case of boats the necessary tackle, apparel, and provisions of such boats and the crew thereof.

No toll to be taken in respect of exempted substances.

4 It shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by further Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, to revoke, alter, or amend such Proclamation as aforesaid.

Governor may revoke Proclamation.

5 This Ordinance and the Ordinance No. 14 of 1867 shall be read and construed as one Ordinance.
