AN ACT TO AMEND THE VISITING FORCES ACT,
No. 31 OF 1949.

[Date of Assent: December 7, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Visiting Forces (Amendment) Act, No. 36 of 1950.

Short title.

2. Section 4 of the Visiting Forces Act, No. 31 of 1949, is hereby amended, in sub-section (3) of that section, by the substitution, for paragraph (a) of that sub-section, of the following paragraph:—

Amendment of section 4 of the Visiting Forces Act, No. 31 of 1949.

“(a) exempts, or provides for the exemption of, any members of the Ceylon Forces or of any of those Forces or any vessel, vehicle, aircraft, machine or apparatus of or employed for the purposes of those Forces or any of them, from the operation of any law, or applies, or provides for the application of, any law in a modified form to or in relation to any such members, vessel, vehicle, aircraft, machine or apparatus; or ”
