AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16 OF THE CEYLON
(PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS) ORDER IN COUNCIL,
1946.

[Date of Assent: December 7, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Amendment Act, No. 38 of 1950.

Short title.

2. Section 16 of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-section (2) and the substitution therefor of the following new sub-section:—

“(2) The revision of the register of electors for each electoral district in each year shall be completed by the registering officer on or before the fifteenth day of August in that year or such other date not later than the thirty-first day of January in the succeeding year as the Commissioner may appoint for the purpose by notification published in the *Government Gazette*.”
