AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCHOOL TEACHERS PENSION ORDINANCE.

[Date of Assent: January 16, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the School Teachers Pension (Amendment) Act, No. 3 of 1952.

2. Section 3 of the School Teachers Pension Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment") is hereby amended by the substitution, for the word "teachers.", of the words "teachers and to the widows and orphans of all or a particular class of such male persons as have been so employed.".

3. Section 4 of the principal enactment is hereby amended, in sub-section (1) thereof, by the substitution, for the word "teachers." of the words "teachers and to the widows and orphans of all or a particular class of such male persons as have been so employed."

4. The amendments made in the principal enactment by this Act shall have effect and be deemed to have had effect' from the first day of October, 1951, and accordingly rules made under section 4 of the principal enactment for the granting of pensions, gratuities, or allowances to widows and orphans referred to in that section as amended by this Act may be declared to be effective as from the said day.
