AN ACT TO AMEND THE LUNACY ORDINANCE.

Chapter 177 (Vol. IV, page 417).

[Date of Assent: March 21, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Lunacy (Amendment) Act, No. 14 of 1952.

Short title.

2. Section 6 of the Lunacy Ordinance (as amended by Ordinance No. 11 of 1943 and by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947), is hereby further amended in sub-section (2) thereof as follows:—

Amendment of section 6 of Chapter 177.

- (1) by the substitution, for the words "discharged by Order of the Minister;", of the words "discharged by order of the Superintendent of such hospital;"; and
- (2) by the substitution, for the words "Any order of discharge made by the Minister under this sub-section may contain such directions as the Minister", of the words "Any order of discharge made by the Superintendent under this sub-section may contain such directions as the Superintendent".
