AN ACT TO EXTEND THE OPERATION OF SECTION 2 (1) OF  
THE GALLE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL (DIFFERENTIAL  
RATES) ORDINANCE, NO. 31 OF 1938.

[Date of Assent: March 21, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Galle Municipal Council (Differential Rates) (Amendment) Act, No. 15 of 1952.

Short title.

2. Section 2 of the Galle Municipal Council (Differential Rates) Ordinance, No. 31 of 1938 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment"), is hereby amended by the substitution, for sub-section (2), of the following new sub-section:—

"(2) Sub-section (1) of this section shall continue in operation until the thirty-first day of December, 1956: .

Provided, however, that the Senate and the House of Representatives may by resolution declare that the provisions of that sub-section—

(a) shall continue in operation for a further period to be specified in that resolution; or

(b) shall cease to have operation on an earlier date to be specified in the resolution."

3. The amendment made in the principal enactment by section 2 of this Act shall be deemed for all purposes to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1952.
