AN ACT TO AMEND THE MAINTENANCE ORDERS (FACILITIES FOR ENFORCEMENT) ORDINANCE.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Amendment Act, No. 42 of 1956.

Short title.

2. The long title to the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment", is hereby amended by the substitution, for the word "PROTECTORATE", of the words "PROTECTORATE OR IN ANY OTHER COUNTRY WHICH IS A MEMBER OF THE COMMONWEALTH".

Amendment of the long title to Chapter 77.

3. Section 12 of the principal enactment is hereby amended as follows:—

Amendment of section 12 of the principal enactment.

- (a) by the substitution, for the word "protection", of the words "protection or of any country which is a member of the Commonwealth";
- (b) by the substitution, for the words "such possession or territory", wherever they occur in that section, of the words "such possession, territory or country";
- (c) by the substitution, for all the words from "were references to the" to the end of that section, of the words "were references to the Governor of such possession or territory and to the authority appointed by, or under the law of, such country to receive and transmit documents to which this Ordinance applies."; and
- (d) in the marginal note to that section, by the substitution, for the word "Protectorates.", of the words "Protectorates and countries which are members of the Commonwealth.".
