AN ACT TO AMEND THE VILLAGE COMMUNITIES
ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 198) AND THE TOWN
COUNCILS ORDINANCE, No. 3 OF 1946.

[Date of Assent: April 13, 1957]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Village Communities and Town Councils (Amendment) Act, No. 28 of 1957.

Short title.

2. The Village Communities Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after section 30 of that Ordinance, of the following new section which shall have effect as section 30A:—

“ The Chairman
to be a
Justice of
the Peace. 30A. The Chairman of the Village
Committee of each village area shall,
during the tenure of his office, be
ex officio a Justice of the Peace for that
village area.”

3. The Town Councils Ordinance, No. 3 of 1946, is hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after section 37 of that Ordinance, of the following new section which shall have effect as section 37A:—

“ The Chairman
to be a
Justice of the
Peace. 37A. The Chairman of the Town
Council of each town shall, during the
tenure of his office, be ex officio a Justice
of the Peace for that town.”
