LN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION REGARDING FOREIGN LOANS 5 TO THE GOVERNMENT OF CEYLON.

[Date of Assent: April 13, 1957]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Iajesty, by and with the advice and consent of the senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon m this present Parliament assembled, and by the uthority of the same, as follows: —

1. This Act may be cited as the Foreign Loans Lct, No. 29 of 1957. Vide 1 0/ 1963

Short title.

Person

The Governor-General or any person specially 2. uthorised by him in that behalf may, in the name ind on behalf of the Government of Ceylon, sign---

- (a) a loan agreement relating to a foreign loan
- to the Government of Ceylon, and
 (b) any bond, promissory note or other document required by such loan agreement to be executed by the Government of Ceylon.

All sums payable by the Government of Ceylon 3. inder a loan agreement relating to a foreign loan to the Government of Ceylon and all sums payable under iny bond or promissory note executed pursuant to such \supset an agreement are hereby charged on the Consolidated fund of Ceylon.

(1) The Minister of Finance may, by Order pub-4. ished in the *Gazette*, make such provision as may be necessary to give effect to a loan agreement relating ∞ a foreign loan to the Government of Ceylon.

(2) Every Order made and published under subection (1) shall have the force of law.

5. In this Act, the expression "foreign loan" neans a loan in any currency granted by a foreign Sovernment or the agency of a foreign Government r by any international organisation. J. N. R 12961-2,825 (4/57)

empowered to sign loan agreea Agreement Con Irack bonds, promissory notes and other documents relating to a foreign loan to the Government of Ceylon.

Sums payable by the Government of Ceylon under loan agreement, bonds and promissory notes to be a charge on the Cousolidated Fund of Caylon.

Power of Minister of Finance to make provi-sion by Order published in the Gazette to give effect to loan agreement.
