IN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE .FINANCIAL YEAR 1957-1958, TO AUTHORISE THE PAYMENT BY WAY OF ADVANCE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF CEYLON OF MONEYS REQUIRED DURING THAT FINANCIAL YEAR FOR LOAN FUND EXPENDITURE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE REFUND OF SUCH MONEYS TO THAT CONSOLIDATED FUND.

[Date of Assent: September 19, 1957].

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent 1 ajesty, by and with the advice and consent of the cenate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon 1 this present Parliament assembled, and by the uithority of the same, as follows:-

:1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Short title. cet, No. 43 of 1957.

Appropriation 22. Without prejudice to any other law authorising for financial ny expenditure, sums not exceeding rupees one 1957-1958. cousand and sixty million eight hundred and ninetyme thousand seven hundred and forty-seven in the ggregate are hereby declared to be payable out of the omsolidated Fund of Ceylon for the service of the mancial year beginning on October 1, 1957, and endg on September 30, 1958, and the said sums may be mended as specified in the First Schedule hereto.

З. (1) In addition to the sums mentioned in extion 2, sums not exceeding rupees three hundred od three million two hundred and forty-nine thousand ven hundred and fifty-four in the aggregate are meby declared to be payable, by way of advance out the Consolidated Fund of Ceylon, during the finanul year referred to in that section for Loan Fund penditure, and the said sums may be expended as method in the Second Schedule hereto.
