AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ACT,  
No. 24 OF 1953.

[Date of Assent: October 25, 1957]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Exchange Control (Amendment) Act, No. 47 of 1957. Short title.

2. The Exchange Control Act, No. 24 of 1953, is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 49, of the following new section which shall have effect as section 49A, of that Act:— Insertion of new section 49A in Act No. 24 of 1953.

" Presumption relating to foreign currency.

49A. In any prosecution for the offence of contravening any of the provisions of this Act in relation to foreign currency, it shall be presumed, until the contrary is proved, that the currency in respect of which the offence is alleged to have been committed is genuine."
