AN ACT TO AMEND THE GOVERNMENT SPONSORED CORPORATIONS ACT, No. 19 of 1955.

[Date of Assent: December 21, 1957]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Ceylon in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Government Sponsored Corporations (Amendment) Act, No. 55 of 1957.

Short title.

2. The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 36, and shall have effect as section 36A, of the Government Sponsored Corporations Act, No. 19 of 1955:—

Insertion of new section 36A in Act No. 19 of 1955.

" Dissolution of the Corporation.

- 36A. (1) Notwithstanding anything in any other provision of this Act, the Minister, with the approval of the Government, may, at any time before any shares of the Government in the capital of the Corporation are sold to the public, by Order published in the Gazette dissolve the Corporation with effect from such date as shall be specified in the Order.
- (2) Where the Corporation is dissolved by Order made and published under subsection (1) of this section,—
 - (a) all the movable and immovable properties of the Corporation shall vest in and be the properties of the Crown;
 - (b) all contracts of the Corporation shall be deemed to be contracts of the Crown and all the subsisting rights and liabilities of the Corporation under those contracts shall be deemed to be the rights and liabilities of the Crown;
