DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRIES (SPECIAL PROVISIONS)

An Act to make such provisions as are consequential to the suppression of the post of Director of Industries and the discharge of his funtions by the Director of Development.

[29th October, 1964.] [1st October, 1962.]

Short title and date of operation.

1. This Act may be cited as the Director of Industries (Special Provisions) Act, No. 25 of 1964, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on October 1, 1962.

Amendment of other written laws.

2. Wherever, in any other written law or any notice permit, communication, form or other document issued, made, required or authorized by or under any other written law, the expression "Director of Industries" occurs, there shall be substituted therefor the expression "Director of Development"; and accordingly wherever in any other written law the abbreviation "Director" is used to denote the Director of Industries, such abbreviation shall be read and construed as a reference to the Director of Development.

Saving for contracts, &c.

3. Every contract, agreement or other instrument or document whatsoever made, issued or executed prior to the date of the coming into operation of this Act by or in favour of the Director of Industries shall be deemed on and after that date to be and to have been made, issued or executed by or in favour of the Director of Development.
